 Advance Neonatal Resuscitation Workshop" organized by the department of Neonatology on 15th November 2019

The Advance NRP (Neonatal Resuscitation) Provider program was conducted at IMS & SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar with prior approval from IAP-NRP-FGM Office (Course ID 4562). Total 33 participants have registered for the training. The course coordinator for the program was Dr Jagdish Prasad Sahoo. The Lead Instructor for the program was Dr Chandrakala B S, Associate professor & Head, dept of Neonatology, St John's Medical College, Bangalore. Other faculties who attended the training program as instructors include Dr Saugata Chaudhuri (I/C NICU,BC Roy Childrens Hospital, Kolkata), Dr Lingaraj Pradhan (senior Pediatric Spl, CapitalHospital, Bhubaneswar), Dr Prasant Saboth (Secretary IAP Odisha), Dr Mangal Chararan Murmu (Associate Professor Pediatrics, SCB Medical college, Cuttack), Dr Asutosh Mahapatra (Senior Pediatric Spl, Bhubaneswar), Dr Rajiv Ray (Pediatric Spl, Sparsh Hospital), Dr Jagdish Prasad Sahoo, Associate Prof & Head, Dept of Neonatology, IMS & Sum Hospital, Bhubaneswar). The participants had already cleared the online examination on Neonatal resuscitation by American academy of Pediatrics. All 31 participants successfully cleared the integrated skill station examination and were recommended by the lead instructor for provision of certificates, which is valid for 2 years. The program was inaugurated by our beloved dean sir in presence of Additional dean Dr Ajay Jena, Medical Superintendent Dr Pusparaj Samantsinghar, Head of pediatrics Dept Dr Mamata Devi Mohanty. The program was concluded with felicitation of faculty members, feedback from participants and vote of thanks by the course coordinator. We are very much thankful to the IAP-NRP-FGM program and Dean Sir, to give us the opportunity to conduct the advance NRP provider training program at our center. Head of the Department of Psychiatry and Prof. Dr Surjeet Sahoo elaborated on the theme "40 seconds of action" and its current need in the society. He highlighted the fact that every 40seconds, someone dies by suicide. Hence, we require a day for "40 seconds of action" that can prevent suicide. He enlightened us about the warning signs of suicide and further he educated us about early detection and management. He stressed that a multidisciplinary approach was needed for suicide prevention.

What reached out to the audience most was the stellar performance of the postgraduate students of the dept. of psychiatry in a theme-based play "The man who remained silent" followed by another play on prevention of suicide by the nursing students. The students elaborated the causes as well as the ways to prevent suicide through their short yet informative play. The innovative idea of presenting a sensitive topic like suicide in such a dramatic and poetic way was lauded by the audiences as well as the guests.

Following the cultural programme there were educative and informative lectures about depression and suicide prevention by psychiatrists Prof. Dr Suvendu Narayan Mishra and Asst.  "CME CUM WORKSHOP ON ROTEM" – Organised by Department of Laboratory Heamatology IMS & SH on 30.1.19.

A seminar was organized on 30th January, 2019 by Laboratory Haematology Division and Department of Medical Gastroenterology collaboratively in IMS & SUM Hospital, Siksha "O" Anusandhan, Deemed to be University, Bhubaneswar. The seminar was focused on Organ transplantation and use of ROTEM (Rotational thromboelastometry) in transfusion management. Nearly 100 doctors from different stream including anaesthesiology, transfusion medicine, critical care, O&G, medicine, paediatrics, CTVS, clinical haematology, pathology attended the seminar. The function was inaugurated by Prof.. Gangadhar Sahoo (Dean), Prof. Ashok Kumar Mohapatra (Director Health Program), Prof. Pusparaj Samantasinghar (Medical Superintendent) and Prof. Manoj Sahu (HOD, Medical Gastroenterology), Dr. Rajesh Kumar Bhola. Everybody stressed on the protocol based management of bleeding episodes in hospitals. They also highlighted the challenges of organ transplantation especially in Odisha which is lagging behind other states. Developing transplant centers in Odisha is the need of the hour which requires infrastructure development and team work. Dr Pusparaj highlighted the concrete steps taken by IMS & SUM Hospital in starting organ transplantation in Odisha. Our institution is already doing bone marrow transplant successfully and very soon will start other organ transplant like Liver transplant. Dr. Magnus Jayaraj Mansard Liver transplant and hepatobiliary consultant from Yashoda Hospital, Secuderabad, AP attended the seminar as a guest speaker and shared his experience and views on Liver transplant. He also focused on the challenges ahead. Dr. Gangadhar Sahoo presented the issues in management of PPH (Post partum hemorrhage) following delivery in obstetrics practice and stressed on skill development and proper training. He also expressed concern regarding the morbidity and mortality of PPH. The greatest challenge in clinics, emergency, operation is bleeding and the major question is the adequate blood transfusion. Blood transfusion brings with the transfusion related risk of infection as well as other reactions. An excess or inadequate blood transfusion is not good and even has the risk of death. Hence an adequate management of transfusion can be life saving as well as saves the products. But laboratory modalities to assess the adequacy of transfusion requirements are limited. It's good news that the technology is advancing and a newer instruments named as ROTEM (Rotational thromboelastometry) has come up which is an aid to the clinicians to decide on blood transfusion products for adequate management. Dr. Ajay Gandhi, Clinical Head from Instrumentation Laboratory, Werfen India enlightened the audience with the issues of blood transfusion and highlighted how to use blood transfusion diligently with the use of ROTEM. It was followed by a practical demonstration on ROTEM. 
